About RubiconMD

RubiconMD is an online platform that allows primary care providers to quickly and easily send eConsults to specialists.

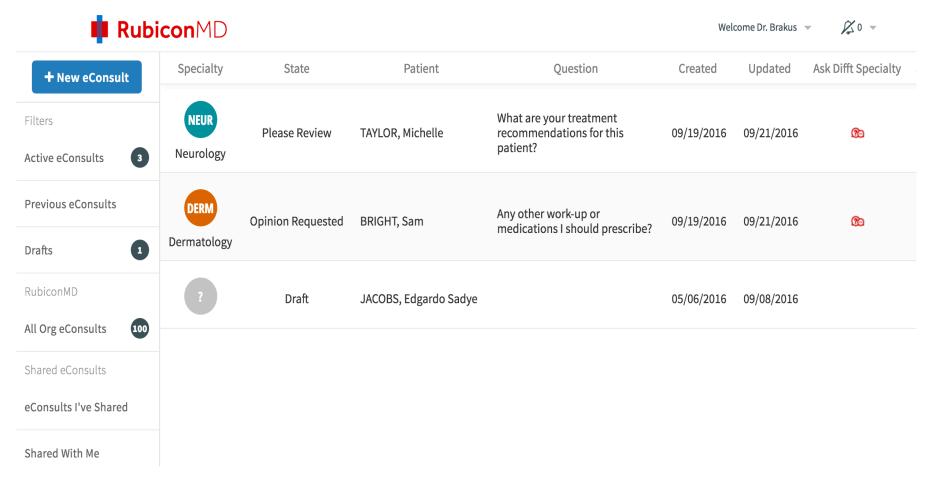
Over 100 specialties and sub-specialties are currently available including Dermatology, Endocrinology, Psychiatry and OB/GYN.

With RubiconMD, you can consult a specialist for clinical questions including:

- medication management
- test and lab results
- pre-referral work-ups

Navigating the Platform

Log in to the platform at **rubiconmd.com** using your clinic email and RubiconMD password. From the main dashboard, you can access a New eConsult screen, view your eConsults, and find eConsults that have been shared by providers in your organization.

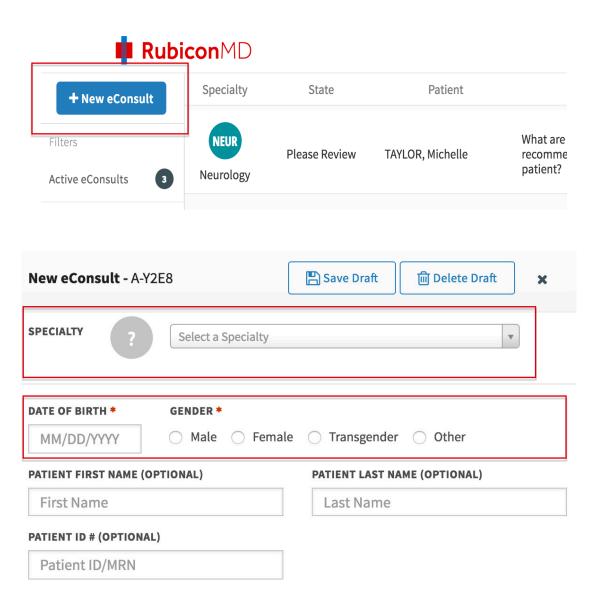


RubiconMD Navigating the Platform

Submit a New eConsult

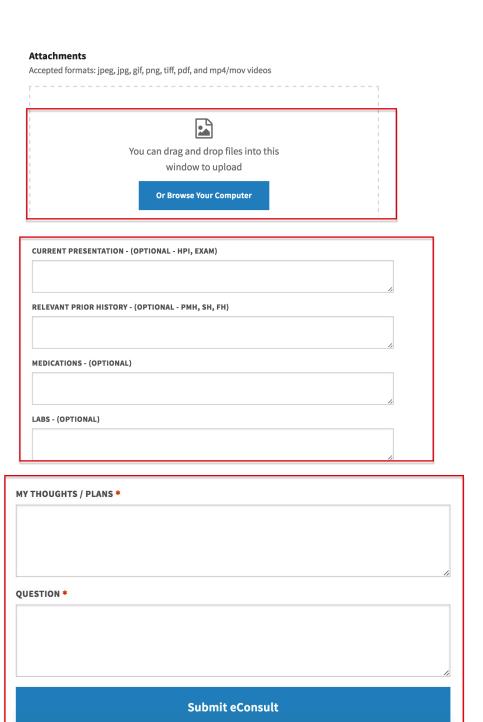
To submit a new eConsult, click the **New eConsult** button at the top left hand corner of the dashboard.

- Choose a **SPECIALTY** from the dropdown menu. (required)
- Enter patient information. (required)



(4) Upload attachments, (optional)

- Add relevant case information, (optional)
 You can inlude current presentation, relevant prior history, medications and labs.
- Provide your **Thoughts/Plans**. (required)
 This is your differential diagnosis or plan of care.
- Enter your **Question** for the specialist. (required)
- (8) Click **Submit eConsult**.

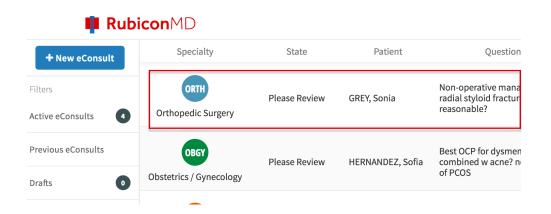


Review a Specialist's Response

To review a specialist's response to your eConsult, click the given eConsult on the dashboard page.

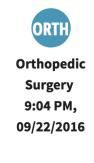
Scroll down to **Discussion** to read the specialist's response.

Rate the response from 1 to 5 stars. Click Explain your rating to give feedback on the response. The rating will help us to ensure that you receive high-quality eConsults.



Discussion

I would place her in a thumb spica short arm cast for 3 weeks--then get her back to office for cast change and a new x-rays--if still looking good, then a new cast for another 3 weeks for total of 6 weeks of cast then transition her over to thumb spica removal splint to be weaned as pain tolerated.



Explain your rating

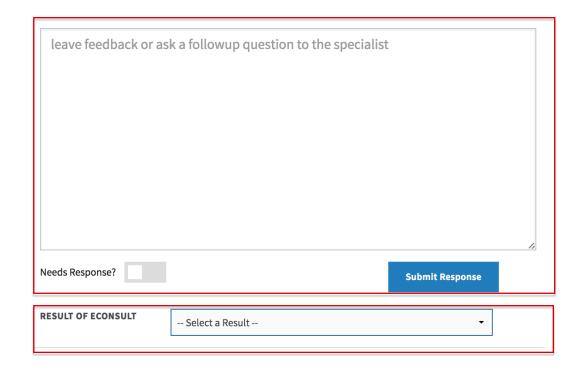
- You can leave feeback or ask a followup question to the specialist within the text box. Check **Needs Response** if you need to hear back from the specialist. Then click **Submit Response**.

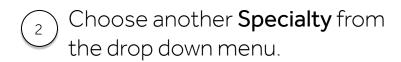

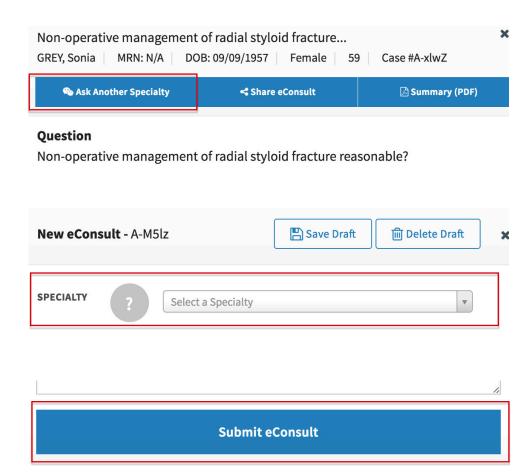


Submit an eConsult to Multiple Specialties

Go the the given case and click Ask Another Specialty.



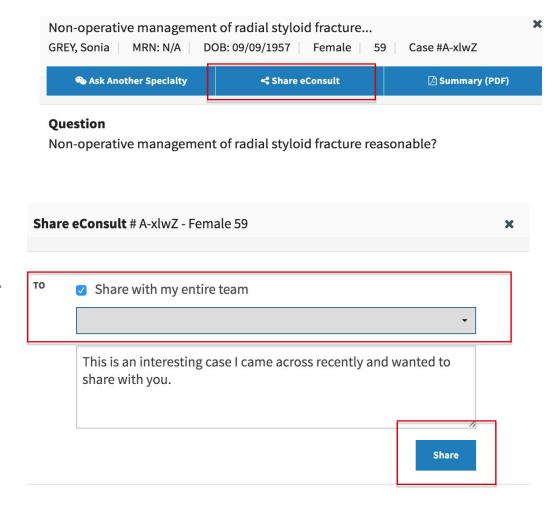
Scroll down to edit case information if necessary.

FAQs

How long will it take to receive a response?

We guarantee that you will receive responses from specialists within 12 business hours [7am to 7pm local time]. However, average response times are less than 6 hours.

Can I submit a case to multiple specialties?

You can submit your eConsult request to multiple specialties with the click of a button. For instance, you can send a patient's case to both Dermatology and Infectious Diseases. The turnaround time for each specialty will still be under 12 business hours.

Is this a diagnosis, advice, curbside consult, etc.?

RubiconMD is an information service and does not provide diagnosis, prescription or treatment of any kind. The primary care provider is free to use the information or proceed otherwise.

Who are the RubiconMD specialists?

Our specialists are experienced physicians who are dedicated to sharing their clinical knowledge and improving access to specialty expertise. Most specialists are affiliated with major academic medical centers across the country and hold a teaching position.

Are eConsults considered medical care?

eConsults are an information service and therefore not considered medical care. It is up to the provider whether he or she chooses to follow the specialist's opinion.

How will I be trained to use the RubiconMD platform?

You will receive a 30 minute 1:1 training session with a member of our operations team. We will give you an overview of eConsults, walk through a use case and demo, and show you how to submit your first case. The sessions are conducted via telephone and web conference.
