# Alameda County Substance Use Residential Helpline



The Alameda County Substance Use Residential Helpline is operated by Center Point, Inc. under contract with Alameda County Behavioral Health Care Services. The Helpline provides Substance Use Disorder screenings, assessments, referrals to treatment, and coordinated care management.



## Who can call?

Adults (18 and older).

Alameda County residents
seeking Substance Use Residential
Treatment or Recovery Residence
with Outpatient Treatment can access
services by calling the Helpline.

# What happens when I call?

Participate in a 15 minute phone screening, where certified counselors assess service needs and make appropriate referral placements into Residential Treatment and/or Recovery Residence's with Outpatient Treatment. If additional screening is needed in order to make an appropriate placement, an in-person screening appointment is scheduled within two business days, so as to conduct a more thorough screening and assessment. For easy access, scheduled in-person assessments can be conducted in both North and South County Helpline Offices located in Oakland or Fremont.

Helpline staff will connect callers to SUD
Residential Treatment or Recovery Residence
with Outpatient Treatment providers for an
intake appointment and provide ongoing
coordinated care management to those who
are admitted into treatment. Any calls received
after operating hours (between 9pm-8am,
holidays and weekends) will be forwarded to
Crisis Support Services of Alameda County, to
ensure callers are not in imminent danger or
need of emergency services. Helpline staff will
then return afterhours calls the following
business day.
