



COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKER TRAINING

Community Health Center Workers (CHWs) are hired directly by our their respective health centers.



COMMUNITY-BASED

Community Health Workers are usually hired by their health centers from within the communities they serve. This maintains the cultural and linguistic competency that our health centers are mission-driven o provide.



REQUIREMENTS

There is no past case management experience required for CHWs. Once hired, they will begin a weeklong training that covers processes, workflows, conducting assessments, and creating Care Plans.



IN THE FIELD

Care Neighborhood Social Workers accompany CHWs on their initial home visits, attend regular case conferences, and provide insight and support on complex cases. The CN Nurse accompanies CHWs as they begin to visit medically complex patients in hospitals, skilled nursing facilities, and patient homes.



ONGOING TRAININGS

The Care Neighborhood community meets twice monthly for continued training, education, and support which often serves as an opportunity for ongoing medical and mental health education provided by CN clinical staff.
